



ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

PREREQUISITES FOR ENROLLMENT

The National Accrediting Agency for Clinical Laboratory Sciences establishes prerequisites for admission to the School of Medical Technology. The minimum prerequisites for a student entering a program in Medical Technology/Medical Laboratory Science are as follows:

- 90 semester hours from an accredited college or university leading toward a degree in one of the sciences.
- **Biology (minimum of 16 credit hours)**
Microbiology (Bacteriology)
Immunology
Human Anatomy or Human Physiology
Biological Science Elective
One microbiology and immunology course must be within the last seven years and cannot be substituted by another course.
- **Chemistry (minimum of 16 credit hours)**
Inorganic Chemistry (two courses)
Organic Chemistry
Biochemistry or Analytical Chemistry
One organic or biochemistry must be within the last seven years.
- **Mathematics (minimum of 3 credit hours)**
College Algebra or higher

To be eligible for admission, the student must either have a baccalaureate degree or must be eligible for a degree in Medical Technology in an affiliated university upon completion of the program in Medical Technology. The year of Medical Technology training will be credited as 30 semester hours toward the baccalaureate degree at affiliated universities.

The preferable minimum grade point average for admission to Comanche County Memorial Hospital School of Medical Technology/Medical Laboratory Science is “**2.8**” on a 4-point scale. Students must have a minimum of a “**C**” grade in ALL Science classes with a “**2.5**” Science GPA on a 4.0 grading scale.

Prerequisites must be completed prior to admission to the medical laboratory science program.
